INITIAL CONSULTATION

Consult with other affected people including civil societies



PLANNING AND STRATEGISING

Use a logical framework to plan and strategise



CAPACITY BUILDING

Build the team's capacity



RESEARCH

Investigate and establish facts for your research

ISSUE PAPER (Green Paper)

Come up with a preliminary findings for public consultation



REPORT AND RECOMMENDATION (White Paper)

Come up with a report and recommendations based on the research and public consultation



PUBLIC CONSULTATION

Get the public to be involved in the consultation

SURVIVOR'S KIT (optional)

Create a toolkit to support survivors after consulting them



PUBLIC AWARENES CAMPAIGN

Create awareness on the issue right from the beginning and at every level



TABLE THE BILL

Get the minister or member of parliament to table the bill in parliament
